Academic Review Program

The Department of Veterinary Clinical Sciences offers the Academic Review Program. The program provides foreign graduates the opportunity to hear current lecture material in the classroom and access to resource material in the library to facilitate their preparation for the NAVLE. The student is able to attend core lecture courses offered to the 3rd year veterinary students in the fall and/or spring semester. Laboratory courses and electives with associated additional fees are not available to Academic Review students. The student will have a computer user-id and password to access class notes and other instructional materials and an email address. The Veterinary Medicine Library is available for resource material and study area during normal operating hours.

Students enrolled in the Academic Review Program will not receive college credit for their participation in the program. This program is a contractual agreement between the student and the Center for Veterinary Health Sciences on a semester-by-semester basis. The College reserves the right to not allow a student to continue in the program. The College further reserves the right to discontinue the program at the end of any semester.

The tuition is \$5,000 per semester. The spring semester begins in January and the fall semester begins the third week of August. Each student will attend an orientation session scheduled prior to the beginning of the semester. In addition, any Visa fees charged (H1 B Visa and SEVIS Fee) will be billed to the student directly. The current SEVIS processing fee is \$500. All living expenses including rent, food, room and board, utilities, books, class notes and other instructional material costs are the responsibility of the student. Financial aid is available from outside lenders if the student is accepted into the program and qualifies according to the lender guidelines. The University will bill the student for the full tuition after the orientation session.
